Awards Of Lions Clubs International

Awards are recognitions for achievements. They mark the gift of grit in getting the job done—and done well—and going above and beyond in service.

The following awards are available to individual Lions who meet the requirements for receiving them:



•Rebuilding Lion Award—This award is given to Lions who have served as Rebuilding Lions at the request of the District Governor by attending a meeting of a Club other than their own and providing assistance based upon their experience.



•Membership Keys—Lions sponsoring new members who remain active in the Association for a year and a day are to receive one of ten Membership Key Awards.



• District Governor's Extension Award—A District Governor will be credited for each Lions Club organized during his year that is received and approved at Lions Clubs International Headquarters no later than June 30th. District Governors reporting the organization of two or more Lions Clubs in the District will be eligible to receive this award.



•Lions Clubs International Service Awards—This award is presented to individual Lion members for their outstanding contribution in reorganizing a Lions Club which had been on Status Quo. To be eligible to receive this award, the reorganized Club must remain in active service for at least six months.



•100% Club President's Award—Club Presidents who, during their term of office, have completed the requirements prescribed by the International Board of Directors will receive the 100% Club President's Award. Award application forms, furnished by Lions Clubs International, must be returned within 30 days after the close of the International Convention.



•Extension Awards—A maximum of two Lions may earn an International Extension Award for assisting in the organization of a Lions Club. A Lion will receive an award for the first through fifth new Clubs organized and for the 10th, 15th, 20th, 25th, 30th, 40th, 50th, 75th and 100th new Clubs.



•Guiding Lion Award—This award is presented to the experienced Lion who is selected by the District Governor, sponsoring Club President and International Staff Representative to assist and provideguidance to the new Club for a period of one year after its organization.



•100% District Governor's Awards—The District Governor is automatically presented with the 100% District Governor's Award if he has met all the requirements established at the beginning of the year.



•Long Term Perfect Attendance Awards—A special five-year Perfect Attendance Pin and pins for every five years thereafter are available from Lions Clubs International. These awards must be ordered by the Secretary.



•October Growth Award Clutch Pin—Every Lion who has sponsored one or more new members during the month of October will be eligible to receive this handsome clutch pin.

•International Photo Contest—The best color slide submitted by a Lion, Lioness or Leo will receive a US\$500 first prize, with second and third prizes of US\$300 and \$200. The slides must be mailed with identifying captions to the Public Relations Division at International Headquarters no later than May 1 of each year
